I. EXPLANATION OF PETITION FOR CHANGE OF NAME

- A. A case for a change of name is started by filing a Petition with the Court. Certain information must be contained in the Petition. The forms that have been provided in this package include the necessary information.
- B. You can use this Petition for Change of Name if:
- You have lived in Clark County, Nevada, for at least six weeks before you file the Petition, and you plan to live in Clark County, Nevada, for the foreseeable future after the Petition is filed.
 - You are at least 18 years old. Do not use this form if you want to change your child's name.
 - You have not been convicted of a felony. Do not use this form if you have been convicted of a felony. If you have been convicted of a felony, you should speak with an attorney to see what steps should be taken to ask the Court to change your name.
